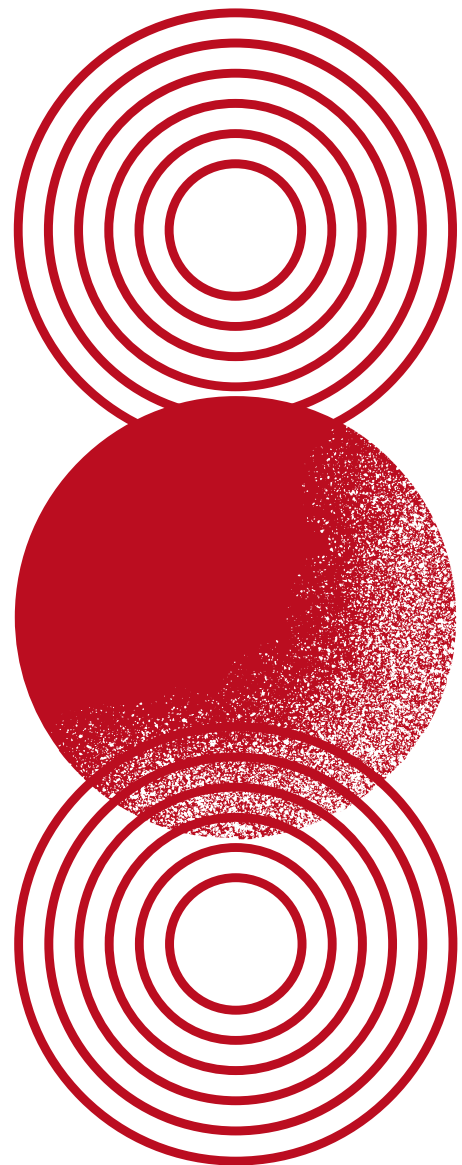
MIDTOWN:

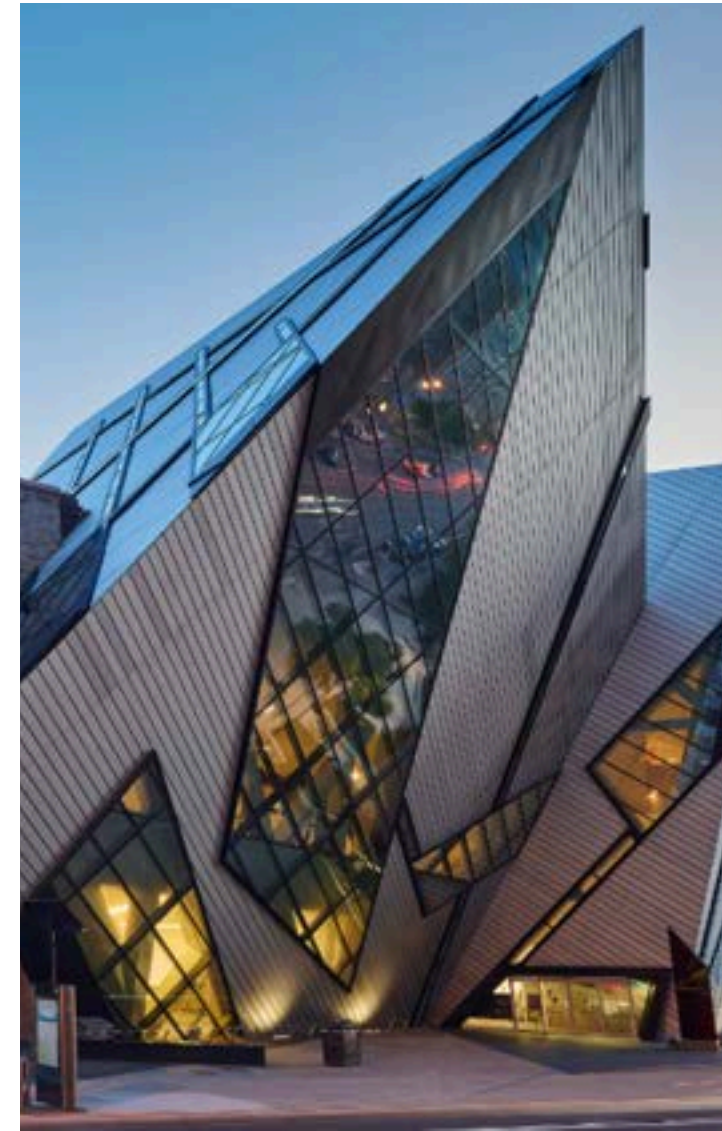
CN Tower
